Teacher Hiring Update

As you know our Steering Team has been and will continue to work hard this summer. Interviews for teachers started back in late May and continued into early June.

We now have a wonderful group of teachers who see the vision and want to be a part of this mission. They have embraced the Principle Approach and want to work alongside parents to instill in the students of FPA these values & principles.

Let us take a moment to say how good our God is!! Thank you, Lord, for being our guide on this journey. It is a blessing to do your work!! In His Almighty Name.

Admissions opened on Monday, June 3rd, 2024. In just 3 1/2 weeks we are at 81 students, which is 53 families who are interested in their child(ren) attending FPA. The Steering team has created a calendar with dates for family interviews and student placement testing. These dates are being shared with those families. A signup genius for scheduling will be sent out by Sunday June 30th.

What can families expect on these Family Interview Days:

- Forms given to parents outlining our policies and practices
 - FPA Christian Philosophy of Education, Mission Statement Exercise, Code of Conduct & Discipline Policy, Sample of Family Covenant and Enrollment Agreement, School calendar, and Uniform/Dress code policy
- Parents will have access to look through the books and guides we will be using this school year
- Students will take a placement test that focuses on Math, Reading, and Language while parents are reviewing their documents.

Q&A

- 1. How long will the test take? It will depend on the child. We have been told it could be anywhere from 1 3 hours.
- 2. Is there a fee associated with the test? Yes. The fee will be \$30 per student. Parents will be responsible for covering this cost.
- 3. What if this would be a financial burden? Parents will be asked to reach out to our Steering team to discuss further.
- 4. Why are students taking this placement test? a. To make sure the child is in the right class. b. Level field, same test given for each grade.

First Principles Team understands each child's individuality and they are made in God's image. We want to meet the child where they are in their learning. We will work with parents, listening to any concerns and make the best decisions possible for their student
